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Dialogue Context: He kōrerorero tēnei i waenganui i ētahi tāngata tokorua mō ngā tohutohu (This is a discussion between two people about directions).

- Hēmi: Me pēwhea au e tae ai ki tō whare, e hoa?
- Āpera: Me taraiwa mai koe, nā te mea me whakawhiti koe i te piriti.
- Hēmi: E hia te roa o te haere?
- Āpera: E toru tekau meneti pea.
- Hēmi: Kia whakawhiti au i te piriti, me haere au ki whea?
- Āpera: Me whai koe i te ara o Huia. Kia tae koe ki ngā rama, e huri whakatemauī.
- Hēmi: Ka pai, atu i reira ki whea?
- Āpera: Haere tonu kia tae rā anō koe ki te tiriti o Katipō, kātahi ka huri whakatematau.
- Hēmi: Koirā tō tiriti, nē?
- Āpera: Āe, ko te 31 tōku whare.
- Hēmi: He tūranga waka kei konā?
- Āpera: Kāore, me whakatū koe i tō waka ki te rori.

He Pātai (Questions):

1. Whakamāoritia: ‘How will I know?’
2. Whakamāoritia: ‘How long does it take to get to work?’
‘What’s the distance to work?’
3. Whakamāoritia: ‘When you finally get to the roundabout, go straight.’
4. Whakamāoritia: ‘Is there a carpark at your house?.’
5. What are the abbreviations for ‘ko tēnei, ko tēnā, ko tērā’?
